FORBIDS CRIME MOVIES.

**Pennsylvania Censors Condemn
Thrilling Pictures on Screen:**

HARRISBURG, Penn., Dec. 2.—Films showing safecrackers at work, tramps stealing watches, and people taking drugs are to be eliminated from moving picture theatres in Pennsylvania, according to a bulletin issued today by the State Board of Censors. A long list of film plays, some of them thrillers, with heroines tied to tracks, is forbidden.

Scores of films in series are enumerated as condemned, including about sixty on the subject of white slavery and twenty-five on Mexican scenes, whose manufacturers the censors have been unable to locate. Prize fighting films have also been put under the ban.
